Victoria, this will confirm the following:

1. Sears has agreed to accept \$3,600.00 as full and final satisfaction of account ██████, a disputed debt with an alleged balance of \$17,545.97, via 12 monthly payments of \$300.00 each, commencing within 30 days of you providing me payment directions.
